#### **ELECTION 1999**

Minutes or notes have yet to be found that report the actual "results" of this election, but it can be assumed that perhaps Sandra Hanks (incumbent) was the lone candidate and therefore simply declared (re)elected. Term is January 1, 2000 to December 31, 2002.

# **ELECTION 1998**

David Gendron was the only candidate that took out nomination papers. All of David's papers were in order and therefore the Election Board accepted David as the new Board member to replace Elizabeth Hollingsworth who did not seek re-election. Term is January 1, 1999 to December 31, 2001. (See notes in board minutes on 11/19/1998.)

# ELECTION 1996

RESULTS: Sandra Hanks 137 votes

Leo Parent, Jr. 106 votes John Laughton 99 votes Kathleen Hammock 67 votes

No other information available. This was for a new position on the board when law expanded the number of members from three, to five. Paul Mokrzecki was the other new member, appointed as the "fifth member". Both these new positions started on January 1, 1997.

Election records prior to 1996 are yet to be researched and assembled. It would also be good to addin the appointments of the chair, and the fifth member.
